


His methods above reproach.

- He knows the secrets of Heaven.
- He has access to the heart of the Father.
 - Whatever the Father speaks, He hears and will communicate it to you!
 - That means that you can be up to date with whatever is current in the throne room of heaven.
- He also gives us indications of things that are coming.



= Fellowship with the Holy Spirit ✓ Steps to Grow in Fellowship

- Share Your Life With Him
 - -Open up the deepest parts of your personality to the influence and direction of God's Spirit.
 - Our thoughts, motives, feelings, attitudes, decisions must be laid bare in his presence.
 - -He must have a say in our future plans, fears, hopes, passions, visions and choices



= Fellowship with the Holy Spirit ✓ Steps to Grow in Fellowship

- Cultivate Fellowship Through Conversation
 - -Greet the Holy Spirit
 - Ask him questions & listen for answers
 - -Invite him to help you constantly as you face your challenges
 - Ask Him for solutions to problems
 - -Freely share your joys and sorrows with him
 - Refer decisions to him



= Fellowship with the Holy Spirit ✓ Steps to Grow in Fellowship

- Read And Respond To The Scriptures "I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better." Eph 1:17
 - Ask Him how the passage of Scripture applies to your life
 - -What should I change? Do? Think?



Basic Habits Of A Disciple

= Fellowship with the Holy Spirit ✓ Steps to Grow in Fellowship

- Find Out And Do What Pleases Him "It seemed good to the Holy Spirit and to us. . ." Act 15:28
 - -Invite Him to help in our day-to-day decision-making
 - -Avoid the sins against the Spirit
 - Major in the character traits that reflect the fruit of the Spirit. (Gal. 5:22, 23)



- Build Closeness Through Prayer
 - Invite him to help your weakness during times of prayer

"In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groans that words cannot express." Rom 8:26



- Ask for help to make listening praying dynamic
- Pray in the Spirit (tongues)

"But you, dear friends, build yourselves up in your most holy faith and pray in the Holy Spirit." Jude 1:20

"For anyone who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God. Indeed, no one understands him; he utters mysteries with his spirit." 1Cor 14:2



- Have Passion For Him
 - Love God's Spirit for Himself
 - Be more interested in the Spirit than in his gifts and what you can get out of him.
 - Tell him you love him.
 - Sing songs to him as you would to a friend. Enjoy his company

"Don't you know that you yourselves are God's temple and that God's Spirit lives in you?" 1Cor 3:16

✓ Steps to Grow in Fellowship

- Partner With The Holy Spirit Ministering
 - Invite him to minister with you as you witness or pray for people.
 - —Ask for his anointing and words

"My message and my preaching were not with wise and persuasive words, but with a demonstration of the Spirit's power" 1Cor 2:4 "The Spirit told Philip, "Go to that chariot and stay near it." Act 8:29
